What is DFC's IAM

Also known as Office of Accountability



Independent office within DFC that provides project-affected communities, project sponsors, and project workers an opportunity to have concerns independently reviewed and addressed.






What are eligible requests/complaints? Template letter on webpage

U.S. International Development Finance Corporation

Problem-solving (Mediation), Flexibility Non-judicial, neutral, collaborative

- Goal: improve E&S outcomes for stakeholders
- IAM monitors implementation of agreements
- Full or partial resolution possible
- Closure or compliance review as optional next step







Compliance investigations

- Focused on <u>DFC's compliance</u>, can take one (1) year
- IAM's confidential draft reports subject to factual reviews by parties and management
- Management Action Plans (MAPs) subject to Board approval
- IAM monitors Management's progress reporting







Threats and reprisals

- Retaliation not tolerated
- No anonymous complaints, but identities can be kept confidential
- Obtain informed consent of concerned person before actions
- IAM may transfer Request to compliance function without need for an explicit consent







Outreach & Communication


- Inform stakeholders how to access IAMs: Projects, Clients, outreach
- Maintain <u>public registry of cases</u>
- Reports to Board and U.S.
 Congress, publishes <u>activity</u> <u>reports</u>
- Member of <u>IAMnet</u>, collaborates with other IAMs





Limits to IAM's authority

- Does not review other entities (Clients, public authorities)
- Does not allocate responsibility for harm among DFC, the Client, or others
- No authority with respect to judicial processes, is not an enforcement mechanism
- CSOs' concerns: "Remedy Gap"





What is DFC OIG

Also known as Office of Inspector General

Independent office within DFC that provides oversight through audits, investigations, and inspections of DFC programs and operations worldwide.

- Reports to United States Congress and the DFC Board of Directors.
- Conducts audits and inspects agency programs, policies and procedures and makes recommendations that aim to improve efficiency and effectiveness.
- Conducts criminal, civil, and administrative investigations of alleged violations of laws, rules, or DFC policy. Allegations might include fraud, corruption, and whistleblower reprisal.
- Protects whistleblowers.
- Coordinates with DFC's IAM, law enforcement, and OIG community.

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Summary
